

Your route to “*The Vibrant ‘60s*” in central London...



Daytime sessions and rehearsals are here

This is the entrance to the Crypt at St. Martin-in-the-Fields, by Trafalgar Square. Sessions are between 10am and 4.45pm. Go through this entrance, down the stairs (or lift) and head for the Neville Marriner Rehearsal Room, where our sessions will be held.



The performance at 5.30pm will be in the bandstand at St. James's Park, about 10-15 minutes walk from St Martin in the Fields. The route is across Trafalgar Square (photo on left), onto The Mall, under Admiralty Arch (photo on right), and the park is on your left.



You can turn left almost immediately into St James's Park (past the sign in the above photo) and take the diagonal path (right-hand photo above) until you reach the bandstand on the right-hand side. Alternatively, you can walk down The Mall until you reach the Marlborough Gate (photo on right), when you will see the bandstand directly in front of you. The base of the bandstand is in the bottom right-hand photo - the full bandstand is only there in summer, and this photo was taken in February! The lake nearby is one of the many attractions of the park, with the London Eye in the distance.
